

## License to access an e-subscription to *The Journal of Clinical Ethics*

Subscribers gain access to the e-version of *The Journal of Clinical Ethics (JCE)* using a user name and password. To activate your subscription, please type or clearly print the information requested and return this license by scan/email to [jce@clinicaethics.com](mailto:jce@clinicaethics.com) or fax to 240-718-7100. Mary Gesford, our subscriptions manager, will alert you by e-mail when your subscription is activated.

**1. The license.** By signing this license, subscribers agree to the terms and conditions set forth in this license. In turn, *JCE* grants subscribers the right to access the e-version of *JCE*, subject to these same terms and conditions. *JCE* reserves the right to change the terms of this license with prior notice of thirty (30) days, made by e-mail, fax, or other communication.

Subscribers will have access to the e-version of *JCE* within five business days of receipt of payment and receipt of the subscribers' user name and password by *JCE*. The e-version of *JCE* corresponds in content to the print version. *JCE* is a quarterly journal and subscription is by volume year (spring, summer, fall, and winter). Subscribers have access to the volume years of *JCE* that they have purchased.

**2. Terms and conditions.** Access to the e-version of *JCE* extends only to subscribers, and access may not be transferred to, or extended to, any other individual or institution. Subscribers agree to maintain their user name and password as private and confidential. Unauthorized use of a subscriber's user name and password, with or without his or her knowledge, is a breach of this license and a violation of *JCE*'s copyrights, and may result in the termination of access without refund or credit.

**3. User Name and Password.** Subscribers will be recognized and authorized by the user name and password provided by subscribers in Item 1 above.

**4. Permitted use.** Subscribers are permitted access to the e-version of *JCE* for which they maintain a current subscription, and may download or print text from *JCE* solely for their private use or research. - a. If *JCE* elects to discontinue the e-version of the journal (termination would be effective at the end of the volume year, after subscribers have had access to all electronic content for that volume year).
- b. Following 30 days' prior written notice by *JCE* to subscribers that any term or condition of this license has been violated by the subscribers, for any reason, knowingly or unknowingly, provided the violation is not remedied with all reasonable haste on notifi-

cation. *JCE* reserves the right to suspend subscribers' access to their e-subscription immediately upon detecting a breach of this license. *JCE* will use reasonable effort to notify subscribers as soon as possible using the subscribers' e-mail address. c. Following 30 days' prior written notice by *JCE* of any change in the terms of this license, subscribers who do not accept such change of changes must notify *JCE* in writing, or by e-mail or by fax.
